

Dear Congressman Derrick:

Last February 7th, I wrote and spoke to you in person about the fate of my Polish friend Dr. Kornel Morawiecki. I have recently received a report from the Committee In Support of Solidarity in which they tell that he has still not been heard from since his arrest, and that there is a rumor about that he has been taken to the Soviet Union. Since the United States has resumed "normal" relations with Poland, cannot the United States Government demand that the Polish government respect basic human rights, and allow a member of the International Red Cross to see him? I am in contact with his family, have sent them more than \$100, and know that they are desperate for information concerning Kornel's physical well being.

I close this letter with the hope that you will be able to do something to help my Polish friend.
