Dear Mr. Ludwiczak:


I am writing to express to you my greatest concern for the well being of Dr. Kornel Morawiecki. As you know, Dr. Morawiecki has been imprisoned and held incommunicado for over three months now.

I am concerned that Kornel Morawiecki has been imprisoned for having peacefully exercised his rights to freedom of association and expression. As you are certainly aware, these rights are guaranteed under articles 19(2) and 20(1) of the United Nations International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights. Poland has signed and ratified this Covenant.

In the interest of upholding basic human rights, I would urge that you ask your government to allow Dr. Morawiecki's family to see him and to review his case with an eye toward seeking his release.
